Obama Gun Positions Listed

The primaries are over and it is a disgrace that only 30% of the registered voters in New Mexico voted. In a little over four months the general election will be held and I urge you all to vote.

One of the Presidential candidates is very anti-gun. I am quoting from an NRA-ILA fact sheet where Barack Obama:

*Voted to allow reckless lawsuits designed to bankrupt the firearms industry.

*Wants to re-impose the failed and discredited Clinton Gun Ban.

*Voted to ban almost all rifle ammunition commonly used for hunting and sport shooting.

*Has endorsed a complete ban on handgun ownership.

*Supports local gun bans in Chicago, Washington, D.C., and other cities.

*Voted to uphold local gun bans and the criminal prosecution of people who use firearms in self-defense.

*Supports gun owner licensing and gun registration.

*Refused to sign a friend-of-the-court Brief in support of individual Second Amendment rights in the Heller case.

*Opposes Right to Carry laws.

*Was a member of the Board of Directors of the Joyce Foundation, the leading source of funds for anti-gun organizations and "research".

*Supported a proposal to ban gun stores within 5 miles of a school or park, which would eliminate almost every gun store in America.

*Voted not to notify gun owners

when the state of Illinois did records searches on them.

*Voted against a measure to lower the Firearms Owners Identification card age minimum from 21 to 18, a measure designed to assist young people in the military.

*Favors a ban on standard capacity magazines.

*Supports mandatory micro stamping.

*Supports waiting periods.

*Supports repeal of the Tiahrt Amendment, which prohibits information of gun traces collected by the BATFE from being used in reckless lawsuits against firearm dealers and manufacturers.

*Supports one-gun-a-month sales restrictions.

*Supports a ban on inexpensive handguns.

*Supports a ban on the resale of police issued firearms, even if the money is going to police departments for replacement equipment.

*Supports mandatory firearm training requirements for all gun owners and a ban on gun ownership for persons under the age of 21.

If Barack Obama becomes the next president, gun owners are in serious trouble. Vote.

Because of New Mexico CCW license renewals taking longer than 60 days, the Department of Public Safety

has announced that applications for renewal can be submitted 90 days before the CCW license expires.

Bills that you need to call your Representative or Senator. HR 5782 by John Bozman of Arkansas will allow any licensed CCW to carry in any state that allows CCW carry, providing the laws of that state are obeyed. Support this bill. HR 1022 would reauthorize the assault weapon ban. Oppose this bill. S-2769 would repeal the Tiahrt Amendment. Oppose this bill.

Charles Dickerson held his gun auction in Las Cruces on June 14th. He had over 300 guns and it took over 5 hours to conduct the auction. The auction was very well attended and included several people from Albuquerque. I sold 23 guns but was only able to buy one gun. For those of you that did not attend the auction, you missed a good one.

Supreme Court Rules On Individual Right to Own Guns

In a 5 to 4 decision on June 26th, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that individual Americans have the right to own guns for personal use, thereby striking down the strict gun control law in the nation's capital. The landmark ruling addressed whether the Second Amendment protects an individual's right to keep and bear arms, rather than a right tied to a state militia.
